



What problems does our service solve?

Concussions are serious injuries that should be treated by specialists

Schools and pupils often get inconsistent advice from A&E and GPs

Concussions can affect a pupil's physical, mental and emotional health

Affecting them at home, in the classroom and on the sports pitch

Medical staff may not be trained in concussion recognition and management

Putting a large burden on them to manage a pupil's recovery

Communication between the pupil, parent, school and external clubs can be an administrative burden

Meaning injuries can be missed and pupils may return to sport before it's safe to do so

Head injuries and concussions are widely discussed topics within sport

It's more important than ever for schools to be able to demonstrate compliance with best practice and mitigate risk

Our medical team are the UK's leading experts. They undertook 4000 appointments last year. They provide bespoke care that ensures consistency with the guidelines.

Our medical expertise and daily clinics means pupils get the care and guidance they need beyond just the sports field.

Our medical support removes the burden of diagnosis, whilst our e-modules empower staff, raise awareness and knowledge and allow you to evidence the education of your school community.

The R2P System automatically communicates injury updates to every stakeholder involved in the pupil's care.

Using our service mitigates risk for the school, eases admin burdens and provides clear audit trails of the clubs compliance with guidelines.



How does it work?





- The school records the injury on the R2P System and automated notifications are sent to all stakeholders in that player. *
- The pupil and parents are sent a link to book an online appointment with Return2Play's medical team. Available 7 days-aweek.
- Automated recovery updates are sent to all stakeholders after every appointment.
- Players have as many follow-up appointments as they need before being signed off as fit to return to sport.




Did you know?



20% of concussions are from non-sport incidents, such as in the playground, classroom or at home.

The highest concussion rates are consistently in the **U14-U16** age groups.





25% of concussions we treat happen to girls. Often, the recovery time for girls is longer.

Being knocked unconscious is **very rare**. There are lots of signs and symptoms that suggest the brain is injured.



Return2Play's daily clinics ensure that there are **no delays in returning to sport** for those who are fit and able to do so.



What other services do we offer?

In addition to our **Head Injury & Concussion Care** service, Return2Play also offer a range of sports medicine services to schools and clubs, including:

Match Day & Tournament Doctors

Pre-hospital-care trained doctor to lead the pitch-side medical team for fixture blocks, tournaments and festivals.

Full Sports Medicine Service

A full sports medicine package consists of our Head Injury & Concussion Care package, match day doctors, physiotherapy clinics and sports injury clinics.
